## General Rules

- Project is open to youth who have completed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade of the current school year.
- Any newborn/orphan animal born in the current year between the following dates
  - Calf – March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025
  - Lamb/Goat – October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, to May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025
- Animals must be purchased and in the possession of their youth within 2 weeks of their birth.
- Animals will be identified on the Bucket Bottle ID form.
- Lamb/Goats must have a scrapie tag to show at the fair.
- All male Lamb/Goats must be banded or castrated (No Clamping) by May 1<sup>st</sup>
- All Lambs must be shorn prior to arriving to the fair.
- The exhibitor may identify up to 3 animals per species (i.e., 3 lamb, 3 goats, 3 calves) but are limited to showing ONLY 1 animal per species at the fair.
  - Identifying more than one gives the exhibitor options of which animal to bring

## Record Books

  - Project questions
  - Feed records
  - Need to be in a 3-prong folder (no 3-ring binder or loose paper)

## At the Fair

**Sunday JULY 20 7PM - Come Check out Your Barn and the Fair Before all the Hustle and Bustle of Fair Starts – Don't bring any animals**

- Animals must meet all the Health Requirements listed in the Des Moines County Fair book.
- Lambs/Goats need to go through Sheep/Goat check in at 10:30AM – 12:30PM on Tuesday July 22<sup>nd</sup> for Vet Inspection before stalling.
- Calves need to be stalled by 7PM Tuesday July 22<sup>nd</sup> for Vet Inspection in the Bucket Bottle Barn
- Get your stalling cards at the Des Moines County Fair Office on Tuesday any time
- Get your t-shirt at the Des Moines County Fair office
- No Grooming chutes, butt fans, kickboards or posts driven in the floor of the hoop building.
- Animals can ONLY be shown in the Beginner Bucket Bottle Show.
- Animals will be shown with a halter or collar.
- All Lambs must be shorn prior to arriving to the fair.
- Classes may be divided depending on the number of entries and at the discretion of the superintendent.
- This animal will not be sold at the Livestock Auction.
- Animals will be released on Sunday. Please see schedule for times

## Interviews

- Interview Location: Activity Tent in the South Parking Lot on Thursday July 24<sup>th</sup> and will begin at 9AM
- Times will be posted on the Des Moines County Fair Office door, Scale House West Door, and the White communication boards located in the livestock barns no later than Monday July 21<sup>st</sup> at Noon.

- Show schedule will be...
  - Beginner Bucket Bottle Lamb – In order of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> grade
  - Beginner Bucket Bottle Kid Goat - In order of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> grade
  - Beginner Bucket Bottle Calf - In order of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> grade

## Judging

- Will be based on
  - 40% Records
  - 40% Interview
  - 20% Showmanship (how you present yourself in the arena)
- What the judge is looking
  - What you have learned about care and raising your animal
  - Your knowledge in the general health, condition, and management of the animal
  - How complete your record book is (pictures are helpful but not required)
  - The fitting or the grooming of your lamb according to species guidelines.
  - The showing of your animal with emphasis on what you have learned.
  - The confirmation or quality of your animal will not be considered since your purchase should not be made on this basis.

- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade exhibitors have additional options available to show their animals at next year's fair; to explore these options please contact the ISU Extension office who oversee those opportunities.
